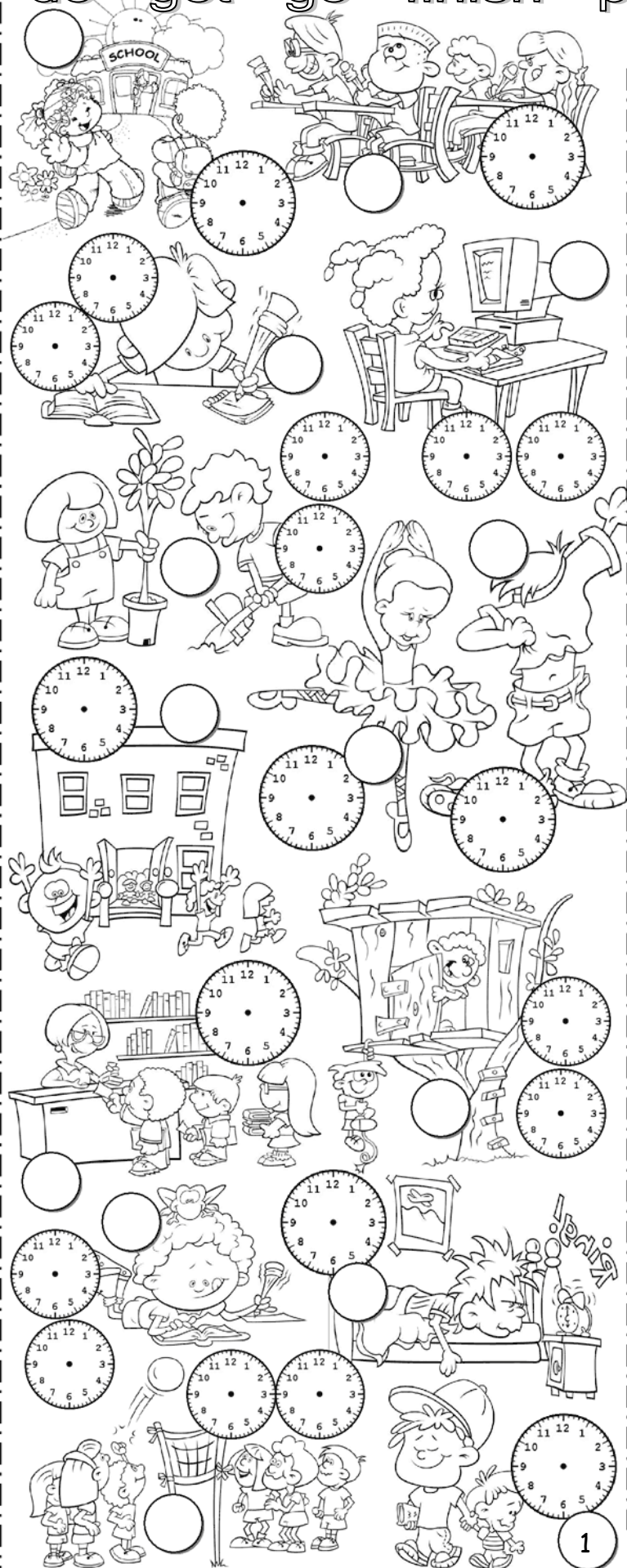

NEGATIVE

- do not / don't + main verb:
I don't drive a red car.
- 3rd person singular - does not / doesn't + main verb:
She doesn't live in Portugal.

INTERROGATIVE

- do + subject + main verb:
Do they like ice cream?
- does + subject + main verb:
Does he go to school at eight?
