We use one/ones when we do not want to repeat the already mentioned noun.

ONE → refers to the previously mentioned **SINGULAR** noun / *se nanaša na prej omenjen samostalnik v ednini*

ONES → refers to the previously mentioned **PLURAL** noun / *se nanaša na prej omenjen samostalnik v ednini*

Examples: I don't know which skirt I liked most, the yellow **one** or the blue **one**.
